Fund check in the amount of \$100.03. Approve to transfer \$5,135.30 from the GUA water to the R.O. Fund. Approve the monthly DEQ water report. Approve the transfer of \$7,750.00 to the Construction Fund. Approve the transfer of \$20,834.00 to the General Fund.
