GEARY UTILITIES AUTHORITY MEETING MINUTES January 9, 2017

The Trustees in and for the Geary Utilities Authority met on the above date to reconvene their regular meeting. In accordance with the open meeting law, the agenda and meeting notice were posted on the window of City Hall, 115 S. Broadway, before 5:00 pm Friday January 6, 2017.

Chairman, Bobby Allen, called the meeting to order at 7:15 pm. Those answering roll call were John Gregerson, Cozetta Johnson, Leslie Swinerton, and Ernest Allen. Ronnie Wheeler was unable to attend this meeting. Also present were City Attorney Raymond Vincent, Public Works director Jeff Choate, Lee Posey, Officer Steve Cerbu, and Elisha Bingham.

John Burns was not present to discuss his electrical issues.

Raymond Vincent is still trying to locate the Levi heirs. He has been unable to contact Tom Levi. No action at this time.

Public Works director, Jeff Choate, read the monthly utility Maintenance report. The crew is in the process of making sure all utilities have the preventive measures in place to ward of this week's predicted ice storm. They will be driving the streets and alleys to make sure there are no tree limbs that could cause problems. The crew has been using the county's wood chipper to chip the limbs that have been picked up. Lee Posey attended an annual Flood Plan certification program at the beginning of the month. Jeff Choate and Mary K. Wright attended a three (3) day Code Enforcement class this month also. The contractor finished laying the 4-inch water line north of town. The crew will finish connecting the customer meters as weather permits. The water line is being pressured up and sanitized in preparation for the Bac T tests that must be done before the line can be fully activated. This permit is for the construction of approximately 300 L.F. of Eight (8)-inch water line and appurtenances to serve the Geary Utility Authority Bishop Property Water line Extension Project located south of the original town site. Approve the transfer from the GUA water to the R.O. Fund account in the amount of \$3,676.50. Approve the December DEQ Monthly report. Approve the transfer of \$7,750.00 to the Construction Fund. Approve the transfer of \$20,834.00 to the General Fund. Approve paying United Energy Trading, LLC \$21,652.05 for the natural gas usages.
