INDEX INSTRUCTIONS

The main INDEX, beginning on page 1, will guide you to the legislation contained within the Code at the time the main **INDEX** was originally prepared. As new legislation is adopted, or existing legislation is amended, the Code pages are replaced by supplementary pages which include the new material, thereby causing some **INDEX** entries to become obsolete. **INDEX** entries to the new material will be provided for in the **SUPPLEMENTAL INDEX**, beginning on page 51-1.

The **SUPPLEMENTAL INDEX** should, therefore, be consulted first since it refers to the more recent legislation. Then reference should be made to the main INDEX. When received, **SUPPLEMENTAL INDEX** pages should be placed directly following this page and in front of the main **INDEX**, according to the instructions accompanying the supplement.

Numbers in the indices refer to section numbers in the Code, e.g., 39-3 is a reference to Chapter 39, Section 3.
